## WP7 survey methodology – Estonia

This is Wave 2 follow-up questionnaire study of the processes in youth's construction of active citizenship in the EU. Wave 2 (W2) sampling bases on the initial Wave 1 sample, no new respondents were recruited. All Wave 1 respondents were asked to leave their E-mail in order to establish contact with them for the participation in Wave 2 survey. After completion of Wave 2 online web form, personal questionnaire links were sent to all these respondents. Data collection was launched in 22th November 2017 and concluded in 5th February 2018. All participants filled online questionnaire. Sample covers different regions across Estonia (Harju, Ida-Viru, Jõgeva, Järva, Lääne-Viru, Polva, Pärnu, Rapla, Saare, Tartu, Valga, Viljandi and Võru counties).

However, only 435 respondents of 1090 W1 participants (40 percent of initial sample) filled online W2 questionnaire. Altogether, 164 respondents (113 them completed the survey in Estonian and 51 in Russian) in the younger age group, and 271 people (263 of them completed the survey in Estonian and 8 in Russian) in the older age group completed the questionnaire.

Respondents' age distribution in the second wave of data collection is presented in Table 2.

To ensure broader representativeness and inclusiveness, all questionnaires were translated into Russian to capture the Russian-speaking minority and their views on relevant issues.
